Car Parking Policy

Adopted 09/01/2018

Introduction

This policy is in place for the health and safety of everyone using the premises at All Saints' Church, bearing in mind our duty of care for one another, and to ensure access for emergency vehicles to the site.

Policy

There are only three criteria for using the All Saints' Church car park: -

- You hold a current parking permit, or
- You are involved in some work or other activity for the church, or
- You are attending a service or event on the premises.

Procedures for issuing permits

- Permits are valid for 12 months from 1 November each year
- Permits are available to those whose name is on the Electoral Roll of All Saints' Church and who have worshipped regularly and frequently at the church during the past 3 months
- Payment must be made to All Saints' PCC at the current rate before a permit will be issued
- Households that wish to park two cars can obtain two permits at a reduced rate

Terms of use

By parking in the car park, you accept the following terms of use

- You will park within marked bays only
- You will display your permit, if you have one, in your car's windscreen
- Possession of a permit does not guarantee you a space at any time
- On occasions, use of the car park will be restricted for special services or events. You will observe the restrictions
- If you do not have a permit, then you will not leave your car parked and go off-site after the end of the service or event that you are attending
- If there are stewards on duty, then you will park where directed
- You must not park alongside the SE entrance road to the premises unless directed to do so by a steward
- Your vehicle must be taxed and insured and have a current MOT certificate if required
- All Saints' Church PCC accepts no responsibility for your vehicle or its contents whilst you are parked on the site
